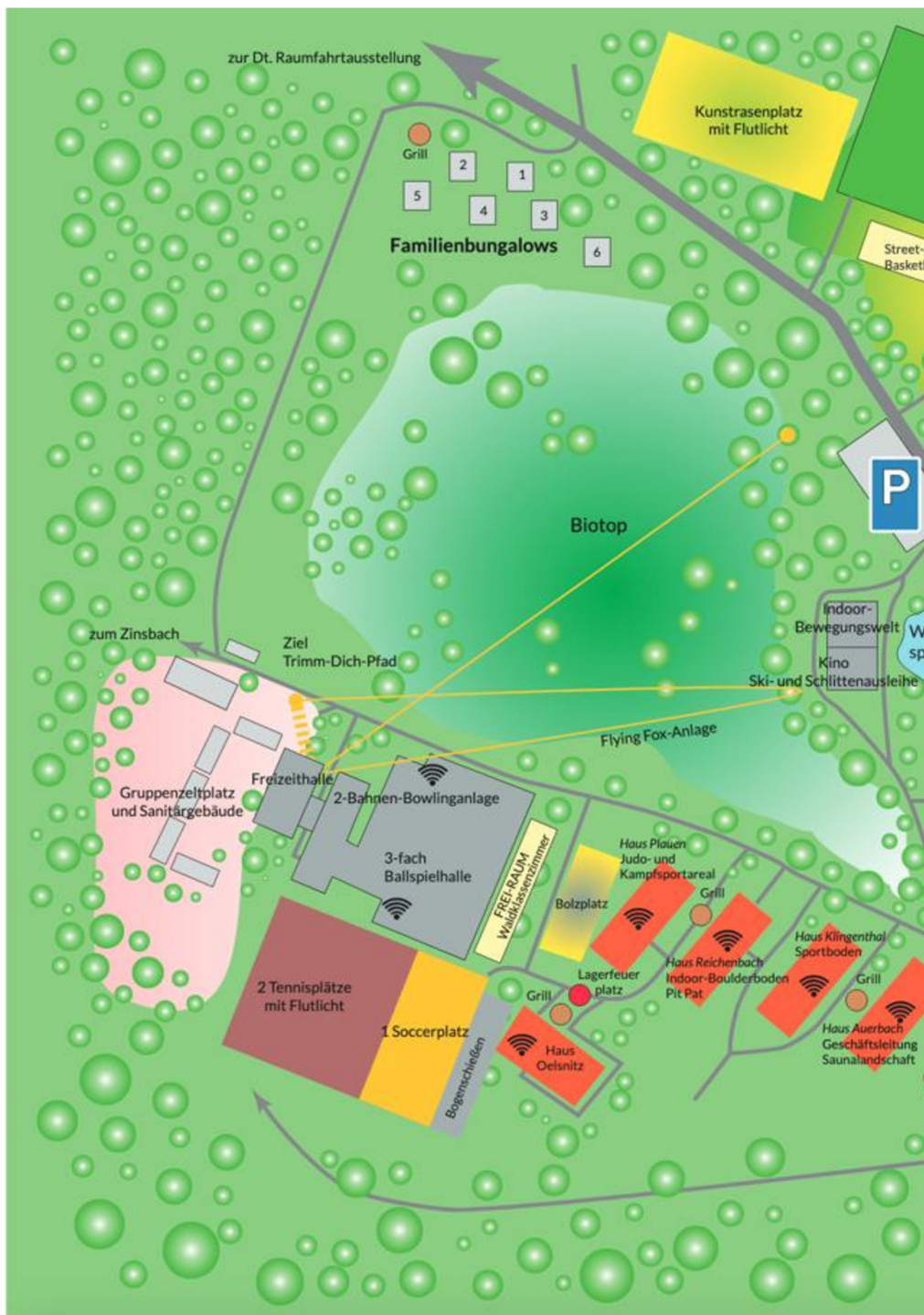

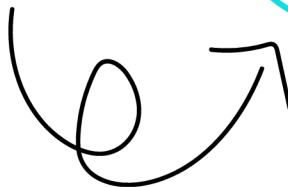


You will find the subjects of the **Seminars**, the programmes for the **children** and **youth** and the **Workshops** here.

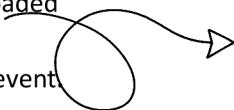

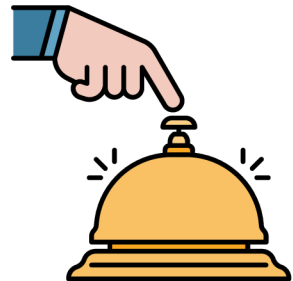

Set free to love: “If you have lost the liberty you once enjoyed in Christ, you may recover. Look to Jesus and accept His Word in faith. In your life you may reveal the faith that works by love. Make Christ your pattern. The light shining in us and forth from us will produce life heat. This love will not be confined to our families, but will spread its branches and produce fruit on the other side of the wall.” – 22LtMs, Ms 139, 1907, par. 22.23 abridged

Set free to rest: “Many gather to themselves responsibilities that the LORD, the merciful Father, does not place upon them. The LORD never compels hurried, complicated movements. Never are His servants to leave one duty marred or incomplete in order to seize hold of another. Christians are to shine forth the light of Christ’s loveliness and remember that all the luster is received from the Sun of righteousness.” – 25LtMs, Ms 21, 1911, par. 10.11 abridged

Set free to go: “The LORD has bought us. No one should bind himself to serve for a certain number of years in any institution. If He moves upon them to take the message to a certain place, shall they be bound by a pledge that hinders them from going? Never!”
– 18LTMs, Lt 165, 1903, par. 12.13 abridged
